As a nursing student you are the responsibility of Institute of Health Sciences, and have to follow their rules and guidelines. You will get more information about this sent to you when you have applied.

Please note that we take third year students only. The Institute of Health Sciences can have up to 12 students at the same time. The months January – March and

September – December are reserved for the students of the above mentioned Norwegian colleges.

Accommodation for nurses students is in the School of Nursing. Also the meals are provided there. The fee for accommodation, including meals, is US\$200 per week.

## Application:

We recommend that you apply well in advance – the longer in advance, the more likely it is that we can offer you a place, or an alternative date. The application always goes through the coordinator at your college.

## Documents required:

Student visitors to Haydom who are not Tanzanian Nationals will need a Business Visa in order to be able to work at Haydom. See the page Visa for information about price and the process. The required documents for your stay are the same as mentioned for Medical Students. If you want to stay more than 3 months you need a Class C working permit that should be arranged prior to your visit.

## Practical points:

- You should bring you own work clothes with you (e.g. white coat, scrubs or whatever you normally wear)
- You will usually have accommodation in the nursing school within the hospital compound. You may have to share accommodation with another student.
- It is up to you to step forward and join in clinical and social activities.
   Students find this a positive way of getting involved.
