MEDICAL STUDENTS

The number of places we have for medical students is restricted to 2 per ward – a total of 12 at the same time. So be on time to apply if you want to come.

Haydom Lutheran Hospital has an on-going program that accepts medical and nursing students that require an internship/elective or descriptive research from their school. If you are a medical student you are welcome to apply for this program.

It would be wise to apply some time in advance. It is also important to inform that we cannot guarantee fully qualified specialists at every ward, so if your medical school requires specialist supervision, you should contact the hospital well in advance to see if the appropriate specialist is present at the time of your stay.

Who can apply?

Haydom welcomes you to apply for the program if you are a medical student at a recognized university or medical school, and you are looking for a practical attachment in the clinical area at Haydom (internship/elective) as part of your course.

Your university has connections with HLH?

HLH has on-going arrangements with medical colleges and universities around the world. If you are from a school with such an arrangement, please approach the professor responsible at your place of study and ask him/her to apply for you. If you have to contact the hospital directly please cc your professor so that the institution can make a follow up. By 2021 HLH cooperates with the following medical schools:

If you are not from any of these schools, but wish to arrange a visit, that's not a problem.

How to apply?

Send an e-mail with your motivation letter, preferred period of stay, preferred wards and CV to expats@haydom.co.tz

The wards possibilities are the medical, surgical, orthopedics, pediatric and obstetric departments. There is also a radiology, ICU and psychiatry unit. The actual placement is subject to availability. Please send us the requirements of your elective (duration and goals).

What happens if I apply?

You will receive an answer from the expats coordinator to approve or reject your application. If you did not get a reply within 3 weeks, please e-mail us because something might have gone wrong.

What should I arrange after approval?

Send us by email:

- a scan of the signed copy of the Volunteer Agreement, that we have sent to you
- a proof of your hepatitis B vaccination and sufficient titer

Information for other students

If you are a student in any other profession, you are welcome to apply for an internship/elective/visit to Haydom Lutheran Hospital. Please ask your professor to contact our expats coordinator to see if a visit is possible. Provide similar documents as the ones for medical students. If your placement is confirmed, please follow the procedures mentioned for medical students as most of the information there also will apply for other students.

Nursing students should read the document “Nursing Students” on the website or visit the website of [Haydom Nursing School](http://www.haydomsn.ac.tz/) (<http://www.haydomsn.ac.tz/>).

What costs are involved?

1. Accommodation cost, there is a **USD 20 per day** charge for staying in our guesthouse (or USD 15 when you share rooms), including meals. We will generally try to accommodate you in one of our student houses equipped with a shared kitchen, living room) and bathroom.

What you should know: Students are obliged to use the guesthouse accommodation of the hospital during their stay at Haydom. More information you can find in the document Accommodation.

2. VISA, US\$ 50 for a **Student Visa**. Look at our Visa page for more information.

3. Tuition fee, US\$ 600. This is independent on your duration of stay (fixed fee), to be paid in advance. See below the bank account.

Beside the costs for Haydom you will have more costs like:

- ticket to Tanzania, between 700 and 1200 US\$ for Europe, depending the airline company and the

destination (Kilimanjaro Airport or Nairobi)

- transportation from Kilimanjaro airport to Arusha (USD 50) and from Arusha to Haydom (TSH 15.000 for 1 seat in the Public Landcruiser, or more expensive if you hire a private car)

- hotel in Arusha for at least one night (between 20 and 60 US\$)

- safaris; you might want to go on safari when you are in Haydom, as the world’s most beautiful safari parks are only half a day drive; cost indication is \$200 per person per day, but is very much depending on with how many people you go and the luxury level of accommodation you choose.
